Attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) is a chronic condition marked by persistent inattention, hyperactivity, and sometimes impulsivity. Studies throughout the world have reported the occurrence of ADHD in school age children as being between 5% and 12%. This means that on average there are at least one to three children in every class diagnosed with ADHD.

Perhaps, you have noticed that your child is more active than his or her peers. They may have a hard time sitting still, staying focused or playing quietly. You've wondered if your child might have ADHD, but how can you know for sure?
