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Homeschooling Procedure- Child Leaving School

The following outlines the procedure to follow when a parent decides to exercise their right to homeschool their child(ren).

- 1) A parent advises the school of their decision to homeschool their child(ren).**
- 2) The school strongly encourages the parent to make an appointment with the Homeschooling Department, in order to have a better understanding of the roles and responsibilities of a homeschooling parent.**
- 3) School provides (either in person or email) the General Admission Process document to the parent.**
- 4) The school must advise the Homeschooling Department and School Organization Department (in the same email) of the student's departure and the parental decision to homeschool.**
- 5) If parent agrees to a meeting with the Homeschooling Department**
 - a) Child stays active at the school in GPI until the meeting takes place;
 - b) The Homeschooling Department will advise the school and the School Organization Department of the parents' final decision:
 - i) If the parent decides to homeschool, in GPI, the child receives a departure code of 25 (Homeschooling) entered by the school.
- 6) If a parent does not want to meet with the Homeschooling Department, in GPI, the child receives a departure code of 25 (Homeschooling) entered by the school:**
 - a) The school informs the Homeschooling Department and School Organization Department of the parents' decision.

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Pertinent Homeschooling Information

- Homeschooling children are followed by the Ministry of Education's *Direction de l'enseignement à la maison* Department (DEM). School Boards are now only responsible for providing services to the children affiliated to them.
- A homeschooling family can **only** receive resources/services through the Homeschooling Department (textbooks, access to resource rooms, complimentary services).
- Homeschooling families are limited to accessing resources at SWLSB's three designated schools (Jules Verne, Lake of Two Mountains High School and Sainte-Agathe Academy)
- Schools are **not** to provide any services to homeschooling families, included but not limited to:
 - Extracurricular activities
 - Sports
 - Providing/buying materials (i.e. textbooks, workbooks)
 - Field trips
- Homeschooling parents are not affiliated to any school. It is imperative that no schools **allow** them to participate in school-based activities, events, or committees.
 - Homeschooling parents cannot volunteer at the school;
 - Homeschooling parents cannot attend curriculum night or any other school activities for parents.
